• On Good Friday, the Church community remembers the death of Jesus by reflecting on the Stations of the Cross.

THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross is a devotion that consists of prayers and meditations that recall the suffering and death of Jesus as he carried his cross to Calvary and was crucified. Representations or pictures of the Stations are usually found on the walls in churches. The Stations of the Cross are a reminder of God's great love. They are recalled during Fridays of Lent and on Good Friday.
